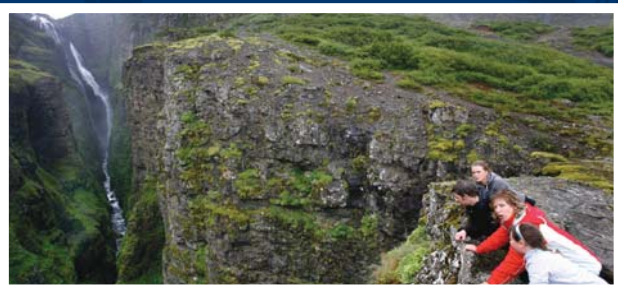

ICELAND

An adventurous country creating memories for life

If you look in your Atlas, you will find an island in the northwest corner of Europe, between Scotland and Greenland. That island is Iceland. The population is about 310.000. More than half of the population lives in the capital area, around Reykjavik, but all together only one tenth of the island, the coast all around, is habitable. The rest is uninhabited, areas with glaciers, mountains volcanoes and unspoiled nature as far as can be seen.



Iceland, the country with the cold name is not as cold as it sounds, even though its location is near the Arctic Circle. Because of the Gulf Stream that surrounds it, the country has relatively mild climate, milder than many parts of Northern Europe during the winter. In the summertime the climate is temperate and the sun never sets. So you will experience 20 hours of continuous daylight!

The clean air and the pure water is our pride. Iceland has magnificent nature with hot springs coming from the earth where you least expect it and Europe's largest glacier, Vatnajökull, whose peaks reach high up and can be seen from the south coast of Iceland.

You can both fly and sail to Iceland.
